

## **LAKE ANN CAMP - SAFETY RULES**

- Please keep all Firearms and Ammo stored properly (firearms in a locked case) in your vehicle, out of sight (trunk preferably), while you are at The Camp
- DO NOT bring any Firearms or Ammo into the Admin Buildings, Cabins, or any other building on the property
- Firearms should be unloaded and cased (locked) at all times during transport to and from the range
- Not Allowed:
  - Shotguns
  - Long-range/High-caliber guns (30.06/50 cal etc). If there is a question, please contact the Program Director, at 231-275-7329
- Allowable Firearms:
  - Pistols and revolvers of any caliber (except 50 caliber)
  - AR-15 style rifles
  - Muzzleloaders/Flintlock

## **SHOOTING RANGE SAFETY RULES**

- ALWAYS treat ALL Firearms as if they are loaded (and off safe)
- ALWAYS keep your Firearm pointed in a safe direction
  - DO NOT point a firearm at anything you're not willing to shoot
  - Know your Target and what's behind it
- ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
- DO NOT cross the "caution tape" at the Range
- NO loaded Firearms except at Shooting Tables/Firing Line
  - NO magazines in the well during transport
- Magazines can be loaded prior to and carried to the Shooting Tables/Firing Line
  - Again, NO magazines in the well during transport
- Cease firing immediately when you hear the "Whistle" or a "Cease firing" command
- ONLY open action and cleared Firearms will be placed on the Shooting Tables
- ONLY enter the range past your table to change targets after an "ALL CLEAR" has been called by the Range Safety Officer
- NO Firearms are to be taken downrange or past the Shooting Tables/Firing Line
- ALWAYS wear Eye and Ear Protection (they are Mandatory)
- NO Drawing from a holster
- NO Eating or Drinking at the Shooting Tables/Firing Line
  - Be sure to wash your hands before eating or drinking after handling rounds
- DO NOT touch anyone else's Firearm(s) without permission
